Report of two day U.G.C. sponsored National Research Seminar on "Degradation Parameters Due to Rapid Industrialization in Chhattisgarh State & Its Impact on Human Health & Environmental condition".

(January 18-19, 2016)

Keeping in view of the rapid industrialization, deforestation, excess exploitation of the nature, over population and environmental degradation and its' adverse impact on the existence of entire human beings – A two day long UGC sponsored National Research Seminar was organized by the Department of Post-Graduate Studies & Research in Chemistry of T.C.L. Govt. Post -Graduate College, Janjgir, District Janjgir-Champa (Chhattisgarh) on January 18-19, 2016 to discuss on this most prominent & burning problem of the globe today & to seek for its remedial measures to save the whole world. The title of the seminar was-"Degradation Parameters Due to Rapid Industrialization in Chhattisgarh State and Its Impact on Human Health & Environmental Condition."

On the first day of 18th January, 2016 the seminar organizing secretary Dr. P.K. Singh, Senior Faculty Member of the Department welcomed all the guests, dignitaries and the participants from the different universities & institutions of higher learnings of India and declared the aims & objectives of the National Seminar. Dr. Singh told that 'The Environment which provides food, clothing and shelter to almost all living creatures of the different ecological habitats, is getting deteriorating day by day. The sole cause of such deterioration is perhaps only the anthropogenic interference. The industrial development-the green revolution and the unsustainable chemical revolution have become the key factor for environmental breakdown. These factors of course, have made human self dependent-at one hand but its unlimited usage have been proved as one of the major issues for environmental degradation & ecological imbalance. The message of the Head of the Department of Chemistry & Convenor of the Seminar – Dr. K.K. Mishra was also read by the organizing secretary Dr. P.K. Singh.

The inaugural session was started, with 'Saraswati Vandana' – the song for the 'Godess of wisdom' by the students of the college in gracious presence of the Chief Guest Dr. Brajesh Singh – noted poet of nature, a nationalist thinker & environmentalist, Smt. Vibha Pandey, Special Guest of honour & Judge, National Legal Aid Cell Authority, Janjgir & Dr. Y.N. Jha, Special Guest of honour & Principal, Govt. M.M.R. Post Graduate College, Champa. The inaugural session was presided over by eminent scientist Dr. J.K. Jain, Principal T.C.L. Govt. P.G. College, Janjgir. All the persons & dignitaries on the stage were honoured with buke, & badges by Dr. P.K. Singh, Prof. Ramakant Pandey, Dr. S.K. Madhukar, Dr. Abha Sinha, Shri N.K. Madhukar, Prof. Jharana Choubey, Prof. Rashmi Sharma & Other staff members and student Union Office holders. The student artists of the college also presented 'Welcome Song' in honour of the guests which was appreciated by the esteemed guests present over there.

Chief guest Dr. Brajesh Singh told that the different types of pollutions have converged to cause abruption in environmental mechanism. There are manifested in the form of global warming, Green house effect, Ozone Depletion, Climate Change, Abruption in seasonal variation, deforestation, loss of habitats, extinction of biotic fauna and flora, raising of sea level, scarcity of drinking water and recurrence of different Natural calamities like high intensity earthquake, devastating flood, uncontrolled sea tides and storm, fast melting of glaciers etc. He further said that thses changes are of course natural as environment is ever changeable but the human interference has increased rapidly its frequency of occurance. Dr. Singh told that we must have concern for the conservation of the environment & ecology. Now a days the five basic elements for the existence of our life – i.e. – earth, water, fire, air & sky are badly affected & polluted due to the reasons mentioned earlier. He also informed to the audience about his remarkable contribution to Environmental Literature, especially the publication of the Research Journal 'Paryavaran Vimarsh' for last many years. Special guest of honour Mrs. Vibha Pandey spoke on the different legal aspects of Environmental Conservation. Another special guest of honour Principal Dr. Y.N. Jha told that in the world summit for climate change held recently in Paris, all the environmental & ecological issues have been discussed and a resolution to prevent our environment by decreasing the carbon emission has been passed. Now it is time to think that how to save our environment ? He further said that the *only* answer of the burning question is "Sustainable Development". At the end of the inaugural session Dr. J.K. Jain, Principal of T.C.L. Govt. PG College, Janjgir delivered the Presidential address and also conveyed the gratefulness to all the guests, dignitaries & participants. He focused on the industrial pollution & its 'impact on Human Health'. All the guests were honoured with Shawl, Sripthal & Felicitation". The inaugural

programmes were conducted by Prof. M.R. Banjae & Ms. Rain Jain. Dr. K.P. Kurrey conveyed vote of thanks & gratitude to all the dignitaries & participants at the end of the function. Prof. Rasmi Sharma & Prof. Jharana Choubey extended their contribution as rapporteur in the inaugural session.

First technical session was chaired by Dr. Y.N.Jha, Principal Govt. MMR PG College, Champa. Dr. K. Kumar, Professor Department of P.G. Studies & Research in Zoology, Govt. P.G. College, Shahdol, Madhyapradesh delivered invitated talk on "Environmental Degradation : A Critical Review" as Chief Resource Person. In this session total 15 Research Papers were presented. Prof. Shailesh Kumar Mishra, Govt. Vedram College, Malkharoda & Prof. Bhupendra Kumar Patel, Naveen Govt. College, Nawagarh (Janjgir-Champa) jointly presented a pepar on "Devloping environmental skill". They explained the basic concepts of Environment, Ecology, Bio-diversity, Eco-system & different skills related to environment. They also presented informative facts about famous personalities like – Sunita Narayan – Icon in the field of Environmental Conservation. In the first technical session. Of Law of the institution reported that total 15 papers were presented including Invited talk & Expert Address.

Second Technical session was chaired by Dr. (Mrs.) Pushpa Bhandari, Department of P.G. Studies & Research in Chemistry, Govt. Bilasa Girls' P.G. College Bilaspur (C.G.) & the Resource Lecture was delivered by the Chief Resource person for the session Dr.

Neeta Gupta, Department of P.G. Studies & Research in Chemistry, Govt. E.R.R. Science Post-Graduate (Auto) College, Bilaspur (C.G.) on "Study of Pollution Cuased by Thermal Power Plants & Its Impact on Environment." The main paper presents in the second technical session were Dr. Santosh Kumar Thakur, Department of Chemistry, Guru Ghasidas Central University, Bilaspur (C.G.), Dr. Lalaln Kumar Singh, Scientist, CMRI, Dhanbad (Jharkhand), Dr. Binay Kumar Singh, Dept. of Chemistry, Govt. Home Science & Science (Auto) College, Jabalpur (M.P.), Dr. B.D. Diwan, Prof. & Head Dept of Chemistry, Govt MMR PG College Champa, Dr. D.P. Sahu, Govt. ERR Science P.G. Auto College Bilaspur, Prof. Archana Asatkar, Govt. Naveen College, Jobi (Kharsia), Dr. Deepti Tikariha, Govt. Naveen College, Nawagarh, Dr. Birendra Kumar, Govt. The rapporteur for the second technical session Dr. S.K. Sahu, HOD, Deptt. Of Environmenal Science, Sambalpur University, Sambalpur (Odisha) & Dr. Rashmi Sharma, Asstt. Prof. (Phy) of this institution reported that total 25 papers were presented including Invited talk & Expert address.

Dr. Santosh Singh Thakur of GGVV, Bilaspur presented his Greener Approach on "Catalytic Applications in Chemical Processes to Reduce Harmful Side Products." Dr. Thakur suggested that by implementing twelve basic principles of green chemistry, hazardous and toxic environmental pollutions may be reduced from good to excellent scale. Out of these atom economy and catalysis play a vital role to reduce the harmful side products and increases the efficiency of the process and renders the reactions in cost effective manner. In her presidential said that rapid industrialization has not only led to the economic development, but on the other hand, it has increased pollution of air, water and soil. Factories producing paper, bricks, metal and developing thermal power plants using coal pollute the air by emitting poisonous gases, which ultimately affect the human health, animals & plants. Untreated industrial water wastes & effluent dumped into the nearby water bodies pollute them. This polluted water is unfit for human use & irrigation

purpose, which led to different water borne diseases, thermal pollution of water is caused by thermal power plants. The effects of pollution are quite alarming & can cause huge disturbances in the ecological balance & health of living creature on earth. Dr. Lalan Kumar of Dhanbad presented his innovative paper on "Life Cycle Analysis of Industrial Products & its' Impact on society" & "Use of GIS for Accessing Impact of Environmental Biology". He said that Environmental Biology – rather like environmental chemistry – compares contrasts and bring together many disparate areas. Mr. Brajendra Singh, Sr. Law Officer, C.G.P.C.L., Bilaspur (C.G.) presented his paper on "Sustainable Development & the 5th Schedule of the Constitution of India and suggested certain remedial measures for the control of pollution.

Third Technical session was chaired by noted Chemical Scientist & Principal of TCL Govt. P.G. College, Janjgir, Dr. J.K. Jain & the resource lecture was delivered by the Chief Resource person for the session Dr. S.K. Sahu, Professor & Head, P.G. Department of Environmental Sciences, Sambalpur University, Sambalpur (Odisha) on – " Our Environment & Health in the Changing Scenario of Industrialization". Dr. Sahu suggested same solution to over come from the problems of environmental pollution. He advocated for the recycling on alternative energy. The main paper presents in the third technical session were Prof. Akhilesh Sharma Dept of Chemistry, Dr. C.V. Raman University, Kota, Dr. Kamlesh K. Shrivastava, Dept. of Chemistry, GGVV Bilaspur, Dr. Rajesh Kumar Rai, Govt. College Dhabhra, Dr. D.K. Shrivastava, Govt. ERR Science P.G. Collge Bilaspur. Dr. Akhilesh Sharma emphasized on the balance between Biodiversity & the Green Chemistry. For environmental conservation, both the elements of balance & control are necessary. Both negative and dangerous activities towards the nature should be checked. Among other paper presents in the 3rd technical session, Dr. Jharana Choubay & Dr. B.P. Yadav advocated for the judicial activism and strict legal action for the persons and organization and who violate the existing environmental laws which are made for its' conservation. Dr. V. Sengupta presented socio-economic view on ecological conservation. Dr. Prabha Gupta & Dr. A.P. Verma presented a paper on effect of rapid in industrialization on the environmental condition with special reference to human health. Prof. R.S. Bhagat & Dr. (Smt.) Manjulata Kashyap advocated for the Green Economic system in the country & The Globe. Eminent scholar of Hindi & Folk Literature & Culture Dr. Usha Viaragkar Athley of Raigarh said that the tribals are the real conservator of forests & Ecology. Their culture, behavior & nature are always pro towards environmental conservation. They are real worshiper of Nature. Prof. V. Sengupta talked about the future of the conservation of natural heritage Prof. Upendra Kumar Verma of Govt. Indrajeet Singh College, Akaltara suggested some practical ways to get rid of Global warming. Prof.

Usha Rathore of Janjgir & Prof. Shashikant Rathore of Baloda Advocated for the Indian concept of energy efficient green technology. Prof. Rashmi Sharma said that by using Bio fuel, we can save energy & maintain eco-balance. Prof. Dr. H. R. Augur & Prof. Mrs. Augur advocated for the strict enforcement of the wild life (protection) Act, 1972 for nature conservation to minimize the pollution. Dr. K.K. Mishra & Dr. P.K. Singh presented their research study on "Physico-Chemical & Bacteriological Parameters of underground & Domestic waste water in Janjgir-Naila Municipal Area". Dr. Mrs. Shruti Shrivastava & Prof. (Mrs.) Ranjana Sahu presented a paper co-relating the innate blend of Man, nature & Literature. Ms Tara Sahu of Malkharoda presented a paper on Hazardous chemicals, its causes of production & its harmful effects on human health & how to get rid of it. The rapporteur for the 3rd technical session Dr. K.K. Mishra of the Seminar & Dr. G.N. Singh AP (Law) of this institution reported that total 20 papers were presented including Invited talk & Expert address.

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An informative lecture on "WEDP" were discussed by each of the resource person. In this session participants were learned the step by step procedure, as if someone who has the ability and desire to establish, administer, and succeed in a startup venture along with risk entitled to it. to make profits and training regarding entrepreneurship.

• **Mr.Shailendrakumarsahu(citconraipur)**

After the inaugural session, Mr.Shailendra kumar sahu introduced students with the programme objective expectations from trainees and with the final goal of the program. He gave students a clear picture of entrepreneurship. Entrepreneurship is the ability and readiness to develop, organize and run a business enterprise along with any of its uncertainties in order to make a profit. The most prominent example of entrepreneurship is the starting of new businesses.

• **Mr.V.Y.Joglekar(CEO,Siddhi vinayak institute,bilaspur c.g.)**

Mr.V.Y.Joglekar sir initiated with the topic of decision making. In its simplest sense, decision-making is the act of choosing between two or more courses of action. Decisions can be made through either an intuitive or reasoned process, or a combination of the two.

Intuition: Intuition is using your 'gut feeling' about possible courses of action.

Reasoning: Reasoning is using the facts and figures in front of you to make decisions.



- **Mrs. Subhdra Joglekar, Director AAdharshila Education Education Academy Bilaspur(C.G.)**

Mrs. Subhdra Joglekar delivered the lecture associated with creativity, body languages etc.

Creativity: Creativity is the act of turning new and imaginative ideas into reality. Creativity is characterised by the ability to perceive the world in new ways, to find hidden patterns, to make connections between seemingly unrelated phenomena, and to generate solutions. Creativity involves two processes: thinking, then producing. "A product is creative when it is (a) novel and (b) appropriate. A novel product is original not predictable. The bigger the concept, and the more the product stimulates further work and ideas, the more the product is creative."

Body Language: Put simply, body language is the unspoken element of communication that we use to reveal our true feelings and emotions. Our gestures, facial expressions and posture, for instance.

- **Mrs. Rajeshwari Sharma, Manager DTIC(Janjgir-Champa)**

Mrs. Rajeshari Sharma explained in detail about production planning in MSME.

Production planning in MSME: The role of micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs) in the economic and social development of the country is well established. The MSME sector is a nursery of entrepreneurship, often driven by individual creativity and innovation. This sector contributes 8 per cent of the country's GDP, 45 per cent of the manufactured output and 40 per cent of its exports. The MSMEs provide employment to about 60 million persons through over 26 million enterprises producing over six thousand products. The labour to capital ratio in MSMEs and the overall growth in the MSME sector is much higher than in the large industries. The geographic distribution of the MSMEs is also more even. Thus, MSMEs are important for the national objectives of growth with equity and inclusion. It would be an understatement to say that MSME sector in India is highly heterogeneous in terms of the size of the enterprises, variety of products and services produced and the levels of technology employed. Cutting across all sections of production and



services. MSME sector is truly a strategic asset for the economy of the country.

Taxes Applicable to MSME: The MSMEs endured business disruption continuously for last three years; started with demonetisation in 2016, GST in 2017 and NBFC crisis in 2018. During the course of the year, the government and the RBI had taken several steps to ease the difficulties faced by the MSMEs. The measures varied from ease to access to credit to ease of doing business and included sanction of loans of up to Rs 10 million within an hour, a one-time restructuring of existing loans to MSMEs, interest subsidy on loan payments for all GST registered MSMEs and relaxation of NPA norms for all MSMEs.

Compulsory purchases from MSMEs made by state-run firms were increased to 25% from 20% of their total procurement and the GST Council raised GST Tax exemption limit to Rs 40 lakh from the earlier cap of Rs 20 lakh.

They explained that how to Develop Entrepreneurial Competencies?

1. Competency Identification and Recognition: Acquisition of a new behaviour like entrepreneurial behaviour begins with understanding, identifying and recognizing of what entrepreneurial behaviour means. In other words, the first step involved in developing the entrepreneurial competency is first to identify and recognize the set of competencies required to effectively behave like an entrepreneur.

2. Competency Assessment: Once the set of competencies is identified and recognized to behave like an entrepreneur, the next step is now to see what entrepreneurial competencies the person actually possesses. In other words, the actual competencies possessed by an entrepreneur are examined against the required set of competencies to effectively behave or act like an entrepreneur.

Where one stands with respect to a set of required competencies to act like an entrepreneur or what is the level of one's competence can be ascertained by asking the relevant questions to a competence.

3. Competency Mapping: Now, the actual competencies possessed by an entrepreneur are compared with the competencies required to become a successful entrepreneur to ascertain the gap in the entrepreneurial competencies of an entrepreneur (Cooper 2000). This is called in the human resource training and development lexicon as 'Competency Mapping.' In other words, this is just like 'training needs identification' in case of HR training.



in a management role, are of equal import (if not more.) The soft skills a Director of Marketing might require could include leadership, willingness to learn new skills, positive attitude, adaptability, and problem-solving.

Soft skill communication: Communication soft skills are the tools you use to clearly and effectively converse with others, set expectations, and work with others on projects. Whether you're a CEO or an entry-level employee, communication skills are of utmost importance. Verbal and written communication come into play every day at the workplace. Make sure you are communicating to the benefit of forward movement of both your company and your career.

- **Mr. Prakash Markale, MBA Marketing(CITCON RAIPUR)**

Mr. Prakash Markale gave the guidance about business opportunity.

Business opportunity guidance: A business opportunity, in the simplest terms, is a packaged business investment that allows the buyer to begin a business. (Technically, all franchises are business opportunities, but not all business opportunities are franchises.) Unlike a franchise, however, the business opportunity seller typically exercises no control over the buyer's business operations. In fact, in most business opportunity programs, there's no continuing relationship between the seller and the buyer after the sale is made.

- **Mr. Amit(Chartered Accountant)**

They gave the formula to calculate the working capital requirement. The formula for working capital calculation involves a simple subtraction of a company's current liabilities from the total assets currently owned by it. Some of the main constituents of the current assets of a company are:

1. Cash in hand that a company has.
2. The stock or inventory the company holds.
3. Debtors yet to pay their dues for purchasing goods from the company.
4. Expenses paid for in advance.



He is manager of shrishyam ware housing industry, banari road janjgir(C.G.). At this entrepreneur experience sharing session, Mr.Ravi Maraiya shared his experience and insights on his entrepreneurship journey, from first starting point to expanding portfolio of activities in the region. He also shared the challenges and phases of ups and downs faced to develop his business, the lessons learnt and mistakes to avoid, the importance of consistency in Customer Service in various local environments, Staffing and management methods to ensure consistent quality.



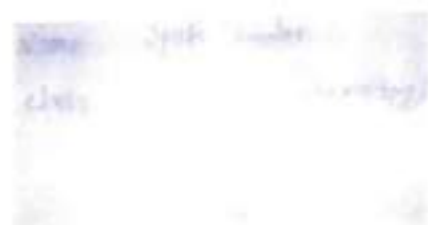

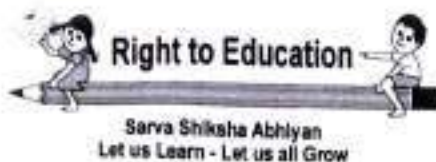
